EMERGENCY CALLS

SERVICE CALLS (No Charge)

INFORMATION — REPAIR — ASSISTANCE

The listings for the above service calls are shown immediately before your local listing. If not shown, call your operator.

INFORMATION ON THE USE OF LONG DISTANCE

After reaching the Long Distance Operator, give her your call in this order:

1. The city and province (or state) that you want.
2. The telephone number. On person-to-person calls, include the name of the person you are calling.
3. If you don't know the number, give the name and address of the party you are calling.
4. When the operator asks for it, give your number.

For Faster Service — Call by Number.

LONG DISTANCE RATES

Station-to-Station rates are charged when you will speak with ANYONE who answers at the called telephone. Charges begin when the called telephone answers.

Person-to-Person rates are charged when you wish to speak to a particular person, extension or department. Charges begin when the specified person, extension or department answers, and are slightly higher than Station-to-Station calls.

Initial and Overtime Rate—All rates quoted are for a three-minute period. The overtime rate per minute is approximately one-third of the rate for the initial three-minute period.

Night and Sunday Rates—Low night rates are in effect from 6 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. weekdays and all day Sunday. The time in effect at the centre where the call originates determines the rate which applies.

Requesting the Charges on a Call—If the charges on a call are required immediately, tell the operator WHEN YOU PLACE THE CALL.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH TELEPHONE SERVICE IS FURNISHED

Use of Telephone

1. The service furnished is for the exclusive use of the subscriber and members of the subscriber's household or the subscriber's employees upon the subscriber's business, and the subscriber shall not extend the use of the telephone to any other person, nor shall the subscriber transmit messages for any other person; and if a residence telephone is used for business or professional purposes the Department may charge therefor the rate charged for business or professional telephones. The residence telephone number of a subscriber may be advertised only in conjunction with the advertising of his business telephone number.

The Department will endeavor to keep the lines and instruments in good working order and undertakes to clear trouble or make repairs with all reasonable despatch, but does not guarantee uninterrupted service.

The right of the subscriber is to use the instruments and connecting lines where the Department may place them, but not elsewhere, under such rules as the Department may from time to time prescribe.

The use of obscene, profane or abusive language while using the telephone is strictly forbidden and service may be immediately discontinued for violation of this rule.

2. The instruments and all accessories connected therewith shall remain the property of the Department and the subscriber shall not remove, alter, or make any attachment thereto. Further telephone service shall be refused to any subscriber who continues to use any unapproved attachment to the telephone after having been advised by the Department in writing that the use of such attachment is not permissible. The subscriber agrees to compensate the Department on demand for any damage, loss or destruction of the Department's instruments and accessories whilst such instruments and accessories are in or upon the premises of the subscriber; the subscriber shall be held responsible for the full cost of repairing any damage caused to buried facilities (drop wire or cable) between the lane and his premises, when such damage has been created from or as the result of surface operation on his property.

Construction

3. When it is necessary to erect poles or anchors in order to carry the wires from the main telephone line on the road allowance or street to the applicant's premises, such poles and anchors in connection therewith will be supplied and erected by the Department at the expense of the applicant.

Charges — How Paid

4. All charges for installations, moves and monthly rentals shall be paid in advance, which shall entitle the subscriber to service with all subscribers connected to the same exchange. Regular toll rates will be charged for all service to points outside of the exchange.

4a. The protection of his service from unauthorized use is the subscriber's responsibility and he shall be fully accountable for such use and shall pay in full the charges for all long distance calls completed over his telephone service, whether he has or has not knowledge of, or has or has not authorized such calls.

5. Subscribers shall pay the installation charges, first rental instalment (and construction charges, if any) strictly in advance. Excess mileage charge will be added if outside of exchange limits. If subsequent rental accounts remain unpaid after 25 days have elapsed from date of bill, service shall be discontinued and no rebate or reduction shall be allowed for such interruption to service.

6. Subscribers shall pay monthly, at schedule rates, for all messages and conversations over the Long Distance lines. If said accounts remain unpaid 25 days after date of bill, further credit shall be refused until account is paid.

7. Subscribers shall pay promptly, upon presentation of account, all charges for other miscellaneous items. If these charges are not paid within 25 days from date of bill, service shall be discontinued.

7a. Telephone bills are due when received.

Enquiries Regarding Long Distance Service

8. While the Department will carefully consider enquiries in connection with unsatisfactory toll service at any time received, it would be appreciated if subscribers would make such enquiries immediately after conversation has taken place.

Vacation Allowance

9. Should a subscriber desire to have his Exchange Service temporarily discontinued, owing to the closing of his premises, he may do so without cancelling contract or having telephone removed, and if arranged for in advance in writing, an allowance of two-thirds of the rate per month will be made for a period of not less than one month and not exceeding three months in any one year. Subscriber shall state, when making application, the period for which he expects to be absent and shall pay for this period in advance. Subscriber will notify the Department when he wishes service resumed, either in writing or by calling at the office and signing re-connect order. Owing to the fact that Multi-Party Line Telephones cannot be disconnected without a special trip being made to their location, this regulation will not apply to Multi-Party Line Service.

Moves

10. The telephone is first located where the subscriber directs and must not be moved or interfered with. When the subscriber desires to have the telephone moved to any other location notice in writing should be given to the local office, at least ten days before the change is desired. The work will then be done as promptly as possible at regular charges.

Joint User Service

11. A joint user is a person, firm or corporation who shares the subscriber's exchange service in accordance with tariff provisions. To facilitate this use of service, a directory listing is included.
Business joint user—one-third of business Wall-Set rate.
Residence joint user—50c per month.

Cancellation of Service

12. Subscribers giving up service must notify the Department in writing, or call at office and sign "Take Out" order. Failing to do this, subscriber will be liable for all charges up to date instrument is removed or taken over by a new subscriber.

Directories

13. The Department of Telephones assumes no liability on account of errors in or omissions from its directories. Telephone directories are and remain the property of Alberta Government Telephones, and subscribers will receive only free issue of the particular directory published, and subscribers will receive only free listings appear. Copies of other directories published by the Alberta Government Telephones may be obtained from the Directory Department at Calgary upon payment of the regular purchase prices. Free issues are printed for the exclusive use of the Department's patrons and are loaned to its subscribers. All persons are cautioned against reproducing their contents, which are fully protected by copyright. Subscribers must not use any binder, holder or other attachments, except as provided by the Department.

Telephone Numbers

14. The subscriber shall have no property right in the telephone number assigned to him or any right to continuance of service through any particular central office, and the telephone number or central office designation, or both, of the subscriber may be changed upon reasonable notice to the subscriber when the exigencies of the business so require.

Public Notice

15. This Department's tariffs are open to public inspection. Information regarding rates for service, tolls and miscellaneous may be obtained upon application from the Department's Business Office.

CONSULT YOUR DIRECTORY

If the number is not listed call Information for the number and jot it down for reference.

SECOND



LISTEN FOR DIAL TONE—a steady humming tone, indicating that the equipment is ready for your call. If you do not hear the dial tone within a reasonable time, hang up, wait for a few seconds and try again.

THIRD

DIAL THE FIRST TWO LETTERS and the CORRECT NUMERAL of the office name, then the four numerals of the number. For example, to dial FAirfax 9-7103 dial F-A-9-7-1-0-3.

ALL NUMBER CALLING—If the telephone number is composed of numerals only, dial the numerals in their respective order. For example 329-7103. For each numeral turn the dial all the way around to the finger stop, then release the dial and allow it to return without interference. If your finger slips while dialing or you make an error, hang up, wait a moment, listen for the dial tone and dial again.

HOW TO USE THE MANUAL TELEPHONE

Consult the Telephone Directory for the correct number before you make a call. Do not trust to your memory.

Ask for "Information" if the person or firm you wish to call is not listed in the Directory.

1. **To Call the Operator** give one long ring before removing the receiver from the hook and then hold receiver to the ear.

2. **When the Operator Replies** by saying "Number?" give the number of the subscriber's telephone desired, slowly and distinctly.

Example:—"175" should be pronounced "ONE seven five".

3. **Face the Transmitter** with the lips almost touching the mouthpiece. Speak naturally, distinctly and not too rapidly.

4. **Keep the Receiver to the Ear**, and the Operator, after acknowledging, will connect you with the number called for. If the desired line is found to be in use the Operator will report "Line Busy".

5. **When You Have Finished Talking** replace the receiver and ring off. This gives the operator a signal to disconnect and you are then in a position to call another number or to be called.

NOTE:—At Cardston, Hanna, Lacombe, Fort Macleod and Vermilion (Common Battery Exchange) no ringing, except by rural line subscribers, is necessary. Simply remove receiver from hook and in all other respects proceed as instructed above, placing the receiver on the hook when conversation is finished.

6. **Do NOT Use the Telephone** during a thunderstorm.

7. **Rural Line Subscribers** should limit their conversation to Five Minutes duration and must not "listen in" to conversation not intended for them, as it interferes with the Service.

Enquiries: Enquiries regarding telephone service should be made to the Business Office, Local Manager, Agent or Chief Operator at the Office concerned.

Information

About Long Distance Calls

(Refer to page 1 for instructions on placing regular long distance calls)

Collect Calls

If you wish the charges billed to the distant telephone, tell the operator **WHEN YOU PLACE THE CALL** that it is a "Collect" call. She can then determine whether someone at the distant telephone will accept the charges.

Messenger Calls

A Messenger call is a Person-to-Person call requiring the services of a messenger to request the called party to come to a nearby telephone. The order should be given to the Long Distance operator in the usual manner.

Conference Calls

You can talk to several people in different places at the same time. Tell the Long Distance operator you wish to make a Conference call.

Mobile Calls

This service provides two-way telephone communication between a regular telephone and a vehicle equipped with a radio telephone or between such vehicles. To make a call from a regular telephone, call your Long Distance operator and give the telephone number and location of the vehicle desired.

Overseas Calls

Calls to practically all the world's telephones can be made from your telephone. Tell your Long Distance operator that you wish to make an Overseas call and she will connect you with the overseas operator. Some typical weekday rates for a three-minute call are: To Australia, Denmark and United Kingdom—\$12.00; to Bermuda and Hawaii, \$9.00. Reduced rates apply on calls to many countries during certain night hours and on Sundays.

Things You Should Know About Telephone Service

Recording of Conversations

If you hear a short beep tone on the line about every 15 seconds, it indicates that the person with whom you are talking is recording your conversation by means of an electrical recording machine connected to the line. The "beep" signal is produced automatically by a device which connects the recorder to the telephone line and is provided by the Telephone Company for your protection.

If you do not want a record made of what you are saying, ask the person with whom you are talking to disconnect his recording machine. When he disconnects his recorder, the signal is no longer heard.

Use of a recorder without this signal is not permitted.

Planning for Telephone Service

If you have a private switchboard or other special service arrangements, a telephone service representative will help you solve any service problems you may have.

Advertising Business Telephone Numbers

It's good business to make it easy for your customers to reach you. Include your telephone number on stationery, statements and all advertising material.

Automatic Answering Sets

Some telephones are now equipped with an Automatic Answering Set, which answers the telephone mechanically when no one is available to answer and then makes a recorded announcement.

If your call is answered by an Automatic Answering Set, listen carefully for the Announcement. Some of these sets will record a message from the caller.

Pay-Station Service

Pay-Station Telephones have been installed by the Department for the convenience of subscribers and the general public throughout the Province. Local conversations made from these telephones should be limited to 5 minutes in the interest of better service.

Long Distance Service is furnished at regular tariff rates upon deposit of the amount of the initial charge (covering three minutes conversation), the usual charges being made for excess time.

Emergency Calls from Party Lines

If you are using the line when another party breaks in to say that he has an Emergency Call, Please Hang Up Immediately, the next one may be yours.

EMERGENCY SURVIVAL ACTION!...

SHOULD A NUCLEAR WAR OCCUR, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE PEOPLE OF ALBERTA KNOW WHAT ACTION TO TAKE IN THE INTEREST OF SURVIVAL. THE FOLLOWING ARE IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE REMEMBERED:

MEANING OF THE WARNING SIGNALS

a. ALERT WARNING:

On sirens, horns, whistles, etc., Steady blast 3 minutes.

Listen to your radio for instructions.

Don't use the telephone.

All members of the Civil Defence Corps will report for duty as instructed by Civil Defence authorities.

b. TAKE COVER WARNING:

SIRENS: Rising and falling note, 3 minutes.

Horns, whistles, etc., series of short blasts, 3 minutes.

Take cover immediately in best available shelter.

IN A BUILDING: If there is no prepared shelter, go into basement or to an interior first floor room. Stay there until you get word you may leave.

OUTDOORS OR IN A CAR: Go to the nearest shelter. If you cannot reach prepared shelter, lie flat on the ground face down, or crouch on floor of car.

EMERGENCY ARRANGEMENTS

a. FALLOUT SHELTER

If you are interested in a family fallout shelter, copies of the 40-page booklet, "Your Basement Fallout Shelter" are available on request from the Alberta Emergency Measures Organization.

Your fallout shelter should be equipped with a two-week supply of the following items:

FOOD AND WATER IN COVERED CONTAINERS
ESSENTIAL MEDICINES
CLOTHING AND BLANKETS
SANITATION FACILITIES
BATTERY RADIO

b. DISPERSAL

If you live in a target area and plan to leave in case of a nuclear attack (if conditions are favourable for such a move), know your dispersal route, and have immediately available a kit of food, water, first aid supplies, battery operated radio, and blankets.

If you live outside the target areas, you should remain in your own home.

You will be informed by radio broadcast as to the advisability of dispersal, immediately following the alert warning on the sirens.

PREPARATIONS WHICH CAN BE MADE NOW . . .

- Learn your community plan for emergency action. Contact your local Civil Defence Director or your Municipal Office.
- Take steps to protect yourself from radioactive fallout. Construct your family fallout shelter if you want adequate protection.
- Enrol for Civil Defence courses and courses in first aid and home nursing.
